

Graduate Education Internship

Fixed Term 1st September 2017 until 20th July 2018

We are offering an internship within school for a graduate who is looking to gain school experience before applying for a PGCE/SCITT course for September 2018. The role will primarily involve being part of a team that provides support within the classroom, as well as being given the opportunity to deliver lessons and provide cover for absent members of the teaching staff when required.

The role will involve working with the whole ability range of students across all year groups and are flexible in order that they can be tailored to fit the strengths and development of the successful candidate.

As well as a good degree the successful candidate will be educated to A-Level standard in at least 3 subjects, and have good GCSE grades in Maths and English plus at least three other subjects. Good organisational and interpersonal skills along with the personal characteristics required to supervise students and work with both the teaching and non-teaching staff are essential.
